The Northwest Bulletin. Seattle: June 5, 1937-December 1938. Ceased in 1940. Semi-monthly.

The Northwest Enterprise. Seattle: January 1, 1931-April 4, 1952. Ceased in 1962. Weekly.

The Northwest Herald. Seattle: October 2, 1942 - Apr 30 1947. Weekly.

The Republican. Seattle: January 4, 1896-December 27, 1907. Weekly.

The Seattle Enterprise. Seattle: May 14, 1926, October 8, 1926 and February 25, 1927-August 29, 1929. Began in 1920. Weekly.

The Seattle Republican. Seattle: January 3, 1908-May 2, 1913. Weekly.

The Tri-communities Newspaper. Renton: January 1994-April 1998. Continued 1996-1998 by ***The Tri-Communities News.*** Monthly.
