- [1] There are 32 fully served unincorporated county areas, 33 if you consider that the Mid-Columbia Library System and the Ritzville Public Library combine to fully serve unincorporated Adams County. Another three counties are partially served as follows: the Fort Vancouver Regional Library District serves part of unincorporated Cowlitz County; Lopez Island, Orcas Island and San Juan Island Library Districts serve parts of unincorporated San Juan County; the La Conner Regional Library, the Upper Skagit Library District and the Sno-Isle Libraries serve parts of unincorporated Skagit County.
- [2] Part of unincorporated Cowlitz County is served by a Municipal Library (Longview Public Library).
- [3] There are both District and Municipal Libraries serving different portions of unincorporated Cowlitz County.
- [4] Unserved population counts do not include unincorporated areas partially served by district or municipal libraries. There are 2 counties whose unincorporated areas are entirely without service: Lincoln and Wahkiakum; and 3 with incomplete service: Cowlitz, San Juan and Skagit. Multiple library service areas combine to provide for full unincorporated county coverage in Adams County. Kittitas County has entered into interlocal agreements with Cle Elum, Ellensburg, Kittitas and Roslyn Public Libraries for service to unincorporated area residents. However, due to the nature of these contracts, which fall outside the Federal definition for Legal Service Area, this population has not been included in the count of those served.
